

Lent 2024

Our theme for Lent this year (Feb. 14 - Mar. 30) is "Understanding Holy Week." Our Sunday morning services will focus on each particular day of Holy Week so we all gain a deeper understanding of all that happens between Palm Sunday and Good Friday. This means we'll talk about Palm Sunday on February 18, Maundy Thursday on March 10, and Good Friday on March 17 before we journey through Holy Week together starting on Palm Sunday (March 24). Our hope is that by understanding Holy Week during Lent, our journey through our Holy Week services will be even more meaningful and significant for each of us. If you have a nagging question about any of the events or parables from Holy Week or want a deeper understanding of something in particular, let Pastor Aaron know. It'll help customise this Lent for the congregation and you.

We will not have a mid-week study this Lent. The Elders think our discipleship will be deepened by focusing on Sunday morning and Holy Week during Lent and not spreading ourselves thinner by adding a mid-week study.

Holy Week begins on March 24th. We cherish the simplicity of focusing on the biblical narrative during these services. They are incredibly meaningful because of their simplicity. However, if you have ideas for how they can be made more meaningful or engaging please let Pastor Aaron, Katie, or the Elders know.
